



School Dress Code

Poseidon Primary has established a dress code for all students that fosters and enhances the school's image within the community, builds school and team spirit and covers safety and equity issues.

Appropriate Student Dress

- Poseidon Primary School polo shirt. Plain royal blue polo shirts with no insignia are also acceptable.
- Royal blue cargo shorts, skorts or skirts.
- Royal blue track pants, jazz pants or leggings.
- Poseidon Primary School jumper or jacket. Royal blue jumpers and windcheaters with no insignias are also acceptable.
- Suitable footwear (sneakers, sandals, low heeled boots).
- Sneakers for physical education/sports.
- Poseidon Primary School hat. Plain royal blue wide brim hats with no insignia are also acceptable.
Please remember, Poseidon Primary is a NO HAT NO PLAY school.
Wide brimmed school hats are mandatory for outside activities at all times of the year.
- Long hair must be tied back.
- Full school uniform must be worn when representing the school at school outings.
- Each Thursday and Friday, students are permitted to wear their Faction polo.

All items of the school uniform are available from The Uniform Shop. The Uniform Shop is located at P & C Central in the Undercover Area (next to The Canteen) and is open every Monday and Friday before school from 8:00am to 8:20am or by appointment. Unacceptable Student Dress
